

Rules & conditions of entry:

- **All classes open to horse/pony and handler/rider combinations not to have won more than £10 in a showing class of the equivalent category since 1/1/2010.**
- Classes may be split, amalgamated or cancelled depending on entry numbers.
- All ridden horses or ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- Foals to be at least 3 weeks old and accompanied by their dam.
- The judge's decision is final at all times.
- **All stallion riders or handlers to be 14 years old or over.**
- Any horse not handled correctly or considered dangerous will be asked to leave.
- Horse/ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
- Hats to current BHS standards to be worn at all times when mounted with the chin strap done up, and by handlers 14 years and under when leading.
- Whips or canes must not exceed 30".
- Any complaint must be handed to the secretary in writing on the day of the show along with a deposit of £10 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- All competitors and spectators attend at their own risk.
- Please, keep dogs on leads at all times.

We can be found midway between Lydford and Brentor, 2½ miles off the A386 from the Lydford turning. Turn off the A386 at Lydford. Follow the road to Lydford Gorge Waterfall Entrance and we are on the left just before the 17t weight limit bridge.

IN-HAND CLASSES

- Class 1 **Best Turned Out** - any age, any sex.
- Class 2 **Best Condition** - any age, any sex.
- Class 3 **Best Movement** – any age, any sex.
- Class 4 **Best Combination** - age, any sex. Will be judged on compatibility of horse/pony and rider, presentation and overall picture.
- Class 5 **Best Solid Colour** – Any age, any sex. Will be split by colour if sufficient entries.
- Class 6 **Best Broken Colour** – Any age, any sex. Will be split by colour if sufficient entries.
- Class 7 **Youngstock** – 3 years and under, any sex.
- Class 8 **Junior Handler** – 21 years and under. Judged on handler's ability. The pony will not be judged.
- Class 9 **Mountain & Moorland Ponies** - any age, any sex. Including registered and unregistered pure-bred and part-bred ponies.
- Class 10 **Non-Mountain & Moorland Horses/Ponies** - any age, any sex. Will be split if sufficient entries.

RIDDEN CLASSES

- Class 11 **Best Turned Out** - may be led.
- Class 12 **Best Combination** - may be led. Will be judged on compatibility of horse/pony and rider, presentation and overall picture.
- Class 13 **Best Rider** - may be led. May be split lead rein and non-lead rein if sufficient entries. Will be judged on rider's ability and not the horse.
- Class 14 **Lead Rein/First Ridden Pony** - Judged on the pony - performance, manners and suitability.
- Class 15 **Best Riding Pony** - Judged on the pony - performance, manners and suitability.
- Class 16 **Mountain & Moorland Ponies** – including registered and unregistered pure-bred and part-bred ponies. May be led.
- Class 17 **Best Riding Horse** – Judged on manners, performance and conformation. May be led.
